BOCES ADVISORY COUNCILS

The BOCES Board recognizes that it can beneficially utilize the talents, resources, and interests available among community members to assist in developing the programs needed for the BOCES. To that end, the Board shall, at its discretion and in accordance with state law and regulation, appoint Advisory Councils of representative residents of the community to meet with the Board to provide advice and reaction about important matters before the Board which may have special significance for the community and/or Supervisory District.

Any Advisory Council established by the Board shall be appointed and discharged by official Board resolutions. Resolutions appointing such councils shall state specifically the scope of the work of the council. Examples of such Advisory Councils include, but are not limited to, Special Education, Career and Technical Education, and Computer Technology.
